## Registered Cannabis Supplier Background Checks

## August 3, 2021

This bulletin is to advise all cannabis representatives and licensees of important amendments to the Cannabis Representative Handbook (CRH) and the Retail Cannabis Store Handbook (RCSH).

Effective immediately, a thorough criminal and financial background check will be conducted on a cannabis representative applicant, the applicant's associates and any key employees to determine eligibility of an applicant to hold a cannabis representative registration.

These changes align with the requirements already met by retail cannabis store licensees and will apply to all new cannabis representative applicants and registration renewals.
