

Liquor Bulletin

Objections to an Application

April 1, 2020

This bulletin is to advise all applicants for a liquor licence and other interested stakeholders of an **important amendment** to the Objections to an Application policy.

Effective April 6, 2020, Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis (AGLC) is reducing the amount of time an objection to a liquor licence application may be filed from 21 days to seven days.

The amended policies are located in the following handbooks:

- Section 2.4 of the Liquor Licensee Handbook;
- Section 2.3 of the Liquor Manufacturer Handbook; and
- Section 2.3 of the General Merchandise Liquor Store Handbook;
